Subject:-Fixing of date of Custom Brokers Oral Examination – intimation regarding.


Sir,

As you are aware, DGICCE conducts the Customs Brokers examination for issue of licenses of which one part relates to oral examination of the candidates who have been successful in the written examination. The result of the written examination which was held on 31.01.2014, has recently been announced.

In this regard, an Interview Board has to be constituted with three Commissioners under your jurisdiction. The senior most member will be the Chairman of the Interview Board. The nodal Commissioners for the purpose of Interview are: Commissioner of Customs (Import & General), Delhi; Commissioner of Customs (Airport & Admn.), Kolkata; Commissioner of Customs (CFS & General), Mumbai; Commissioner of Customs (Port-Import), Chennai and Commissioner of Customs, Bangalore.

As per consultation with Director General of Inspection, the dates for the Interview have been fixed for 14th and 15th October, 2014. Instructions for the Interview Board are enclosed with this letter.

Instructions for Chairman and Members of Interview Board and Nodal Commissioners for conduct of Oral examination for Customs Brokers

The marksheet(s) of written examination for Customs Brokers held on 31.01.2014 in terms of Regulation '6' of Customs Brokers Licensing Regulation 2013 have already been sent to the concerned Commissionerates for declaration of result. The copy of the marks sheets is being enclosed for your ready reference. The candidates who have qualified in the written test (i.e. who have obtained minimum 50 Marks) are now required to undergo an Oral Examination/ Interview.

The pass marks for the Oral Examination/Interview will be 50 out of 100 marks. The Director General of Inspection has decided that the Oral Examination will be conducted by 5 separate Interview Boards comprising of three members in each Interview Board to be constituted by the zonal Chief Commissioners. **The senior most Commissioner in each Interview Board will be the Chairman of the Interview Board.** The names of the centres and Commissionerates from which the candidates will be examined by the concerned Interview Boards are detailed below:

4.	Chennai	Chennai, Coimbatore, Tuticorin, Trichi, Visakhapatnam (Customs) Visakhapatnam-II, Hyderabad-II, Guntur, Calicut
5.	Bangalore	Bangalore, Mangalore, Cochin, Thiruvananthpuram

The Commissioner of Customs (Import & General), Delhi; Commissioner of Customs (Airport & Admn.), Kolkata; Commissioner of Customs (CFS & General), Mumbai; Commissioner of Customs (Port-Import), Chennai and Commissioner of


Customs, Bangaluru, will be the nodal Commissionerates to make necessary arrangements for the Oral examination at their centers.

The nodal Commissioners are required to immediately contact the concerned Commissionerates, convey to them the date(s) on which the candidates will be interviewed by the Interview Board and call for a list of eligible candidates. The Interview may be completed on 14th & 15th October, 2014.

The candidates who could not clear the Oral Examination held in the past are also eligible to appear in this oral Examination/ Interview provided they are eligible for the purpose as per the provisions under the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulation, 2013. The eligibility aspect is to be examined by the concerned Commissionerate/ Customs House, who would forward names of such eligible candidates to the oral examination/ Interview Board.

The mark sheets of the oral examination may please be sent in sealed cover by name to Shri Unmesh Sharad Wagh, Additional Director, DGICCE, New Delhi immediately after completion of orals.
